Early Check-in

- When: Thursday, July 13 from 4:00 8:00 p.m.

Check-in Friday, July 14 – AT LEAST 90 minutes before your first game!

- When: Friday, July 14 starting at 8:30am
- Where:Tournament Headquarters @ THPRDUnder the blue tents at the end of Field #1Howard Terpenning Sports Complex THPRD (Rec Center)NW 158th and NW Schendel Avenue, Beaverton, OR 97006

Players May <u>Only Be Rostered to and Play on One Team</u> for the Entire Tournament

The following needs to be presented at tournament check-in

- 1. Team Roster^{*} seven <u>IDENTICAL copies</u> and roster must include:
 - Coaches and Managers (MUST have valid coaching card)
 - Player's Full Name as it appears on his/her player card
 - Date of Birth
 - Jersey Number
 - CROSS off any players that are NOT playing (with black sharpie easier to cover)
- 2. Player Cards** with picture laminated NOT EXPIRED. If this is not possible then your roster MUST verified/approved and be signed by your Club Registrar.
- 3. Medical Releases for each player on your roster

Valid Types of Rosters for Teams carded through USYSA

- Official State generated roster for teams participating under their USYS State Association Cards must ALL be USYS cards – from Affinity use the PRINT GAME CARD button
- Typed Roster MUST have players name as it appears on player card/DOB/Jersey # <u>FILLABLE Roster Template if available on our website</u> (this is clickable as well)

Valid Types of Rosters for Teams carded through US CLUB SOCCER

• Official US Club Soccer roster for teams registered with US Club Soccer Cards must all be US Club Soccer cards and loan forms are required if you are using a player from outside your club, even borrowed players cards must be US Club Soccer.

Player Cards

- A team **may not mix** US Club Soccer cards with USYS cards.
- Every Player & Coach on the team must have the same type of player card.
- Cards must have photo and be laminated.
- If using Cards to check in they **must not be expired** –players & coaches MUST have valid cards
 - US Club Soccer cards valid through at least 8/1/23
 - o USYS Cards (2022-2023 or 2023-2024 season)

WHEN is a Birth Certificate or Passport is required

ONLY - USYS Recreational Player Cards – REQUIRE a birth certificate or passport as age verification. This is because Recreational players are not age verified before being carded

USYS Competitive Player Cards - DO NOT USYS Developmental Player Cards - DO NOT US Club Soccer Cards – DO NOT

Travel papers

No travel papers are needed

Help us check-in your team faster!

- Have your roster, player cards (and if you have Recreational Cards** the birth doc/passport) in the same order so we can easily verify your documents.
- Make sure your jersey numbers are on ALL copies of your rosters
- Make sure that players that are not playing are crossed off ALL copies of your roster NEATLY
- Remember to make sure your roster size does not exceed the tournament allowed size. (see rules)
- MAKE sure that no player on your roster is on another roster for Beaverton Cup.

REQUIRED for EACH Game:

• **<u>ROSTER -</u>** Teams will be required to present one Beaverton Cup stamped roster to the referee prior to each game – your rosters will be stamped when you check in your team.

NOT REQUIRED BUT YOU MUST HAVE WITH YOU:

- CARDS You do not need to present player cards again to the referee on the field
- **MEDICAL RELEASES** need to remain on the FIELD with a team official during ALL games in the event that they need to be reviewed by a Beaverton Cup official and in case of an emergency.
